Outcome of Second Study on Impact of Pressure Cookers on LPG

Consumption

Dear Mr. Rahman,

The purpose of this communication is to formally apprise your esteemed office of the outcomes derived from the second study conducted on the impact of pressure cookers on LPG consumption as presented to you on 1 April at your office and suggest a revised refill cycle for the LPG distribution.

Based on the findings of the study, UNHCR intends to modify its refill cycle by establishing a distinct refill schedule tailored to each household size, thereby enhancing targeting. The revised refill schedule, outlined below, is informed by the aforementioned pressure cooker study and the observed LPG consumption patterns at the household level.
