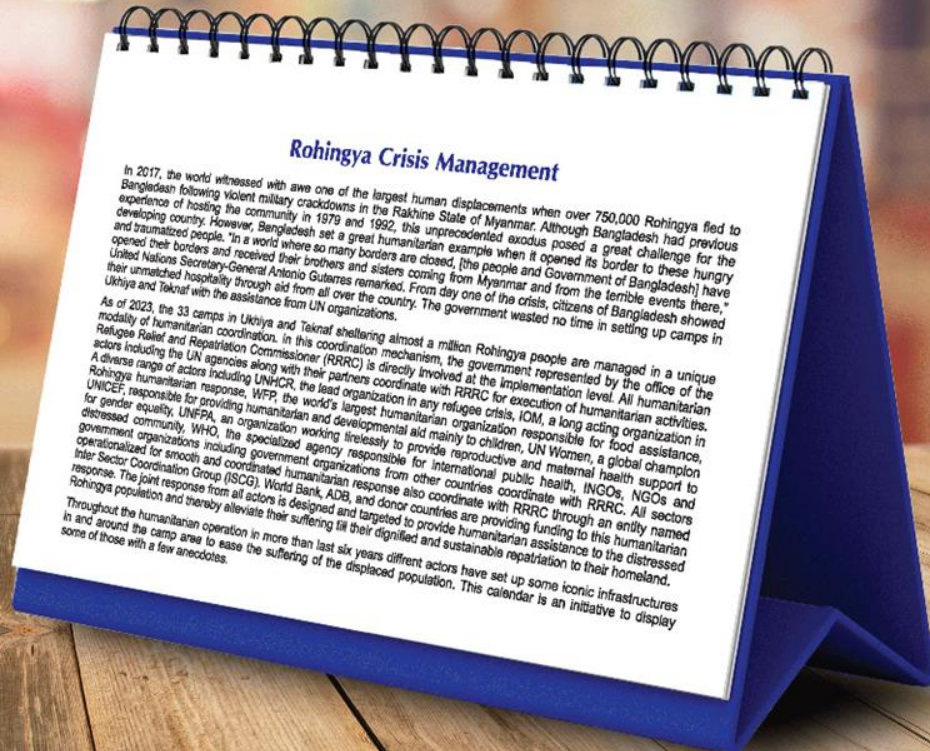

Rohingya Crisis Management

This office was established in 1992 following the arrival of an estimated 250,000 Rohingya people into Bangladesh from the Rakhine State in Myanmar. Headed by the RRRC, the office is located in the Cox's Bazar town of Bangladesh, approximately 390 km south-west of its capital city, Dhaka. Functioning under the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief (MoDMR), it is responsible for the provision of humanitarian assistance for the Rohingya population in Bangladesh with support of the United Nations (UN) and the international community. The overall management of the humanitarian response lies with this office and hence it, in coordination with other government organizations and UN agencies, has been planning, coordinating and monitoring the humanitarian response programmes run by a wide range of humanitarian actors including international and national NGOs. The office is also committed to permanent solutions of the Rohingya humanitarian crisis by planning safe and dignified repatriation of the Forcibly Displaced Myanmar Nationals (FDMNs) and facilitating the resettlement of Rohingyas in third countries.

Delving into history, Bangladesh has experienced a number of Rohingya exoduses, but the influx that took place between August 2017 and January 2018 was unprecedented. To save their lives from the ruthless oppressions, diabolic atrocities and brutal onslaught unleashed by Myanmar military in the name of "clearance operations", more than 750,000 Rohingyas took shelter in Bangladesh. With newborns and natural deaths, currently the Rohingya population in Bangladesh stands at around 1 million, majority of whom are living in the camps in Ukhiya and Teknaf Upazila of Cox's Bazar. Around 32,000 have been relocated to Bhasanchar in Noakhali district. The Government of Bangladesh pledges to continue humanitarian assistance till a sustainable solution to the Rohingya crisis is achieved.

Satellite Fire Station

Over the past few years, several incidents of fire in camps had wreaked havoc and destroyed lives of Rohingya community and adjacent host community. To mitigate the damage caused by fire, satellite fire stations are set up in different camps, with the funding from World Bank, alongside UN agencies, NGOs have set up several Mobile Fire Fighting Units with small vehicles locally known as "Tuktuk", which are used to have better access in the congested camp areas. Bangladesh Fire Service and Civil Defense coordinates with these stations and are assisted by whenever there is a fire incident nearby.



Since inavailability of the ground water in Teknaf is acute, more than 2,00,000 Rohingyas along with 3,00,000 local community have been suffering from scarcity of drinking water. RRRC office with the support from UNHCR has been managing an artificial lake at the very outskirts of the Nayapara camp and trucking the water regularly to quench the need of the people by a rationing system. Rationing even goes down to 5 litre per person per day if there is no rain in late April (God forbid).

To create a conservation-innovation platform, Rohingya Cultural Memory Centre (RCMC), alternatively known as Rohingya Rosemor Ghor was launched in 2021 in Camp 18 by IOM. RCMC is a tool to address the community's 'identity crisis' and platform for Rohingya community to tell their stories through traditional embroidery, pottery, basketry, woodwork of boats, models of their houses, farming objects, furniture, visual arts, music, storytelling, poetry, and more. From individual items to collectively-made large scale objects, these artworks are a portrait of Rohingya identity, traditional domestic and cultural life as seen by Rohingya community.



Omni Processor

Located in Camp 4 Extn, world's third omni processor and the first in Bangladesh, started a trial run in Ukhija, Cox's Bazar after Honorable Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina inaugurated the project in November, 2023. It was implemented by the DPHE and was delivered by Ankur Scientific of India and SR Corporation of Bangladesh, with financial support from ADB. In the pilot phase, 30 cubic meters or 8 tonnes of dry sewage waste, 5 tonnes of organic waste, 500kg of plastic waste-a total of 11.5 tonnes of sewage can be processed every day to generate average 60-70 kilowatts of electricity it needs daily.

Bhasanchar

Bhasanchar is an island in Noakhali district and the current home to around 32,000 Rohingya population. Established as Aekheyah-3 project by Bangladesh Navy, this Rohingya accommodation project apart from camps in Cox's Bazar has the capacity to accommodate around 100,000 in its current establishment. Relocation from Cox's Bazar camps started in December, 2021 and still goes on in regular basis. Bhasanchar consists of 13000 acres of total land area, of which 1102 acres are inside embankment, has 120 clusters in total, and each cluster has 12 compartments and each compartment has 16 rooms.

Ukhiya Specialised Hospital

It came into operation in 2022 following the signing of MoU among MoDMR, MoFW and UNHCR. The Government of Bangladesh and UNHCR have a long-standing operational partnership to improve and expand health service delivery from the facility. It currently provides specialized outpatient services for surgery, trauma care, eye and dental care, physiotherapy, palliative care, including a 24/7 emergency unit, laboratory and diagnostic facility for both the adjacent Bangladeshi community and Rohingya community in camps.

Multipurpose Centres

A maintenance room is also on the roof. A very mild memo is there for people with special need. After completion, these buildings will be handed over to the Camp-In-Charges (CICs), on behalf of RRRCC, and will be operated by them.

A WFS that own Aga Khan Award

It features a complex roof truss built by Rohingya bamboo workers without drawings or models. A safe space offering practical support to women and girls employed local materials and an exterior scheme that avoids the disturbance caused to visiting elephants by the blues and pinks of standard camp structures. One community support centre uses colourful mattresses as roof insulation, another mixes natural materials with industrial ones; another is built around existing bezel nut trees, resisting the tendency to deforestation.
