Subject: COVID-19 Preparedness and Response.

In the reference of the above subject, this is to apprise you that the COVID situation in the FDMN camps does not improve substantially that triggers this office to continue the restrictions imposed on the regular activities of the humanitarian actors/agencies as follows:

- 1) No actor, except Health, Food, LPG (all camps) & shelter (camp 9, 8E & 8W), will continue their regular activities at camp level w.e.f 01.06.2021 to 07.06.2021;
- 2) The actor responsible for distribution of Tie down Kits (TDK) as monsoon preparedness under DRR will carry on with the task subject to COVID guidelines;
- 3) Food, health & nutrition and NFI (LPG) sector/actor will persist with their regular activities under COVID 19 protocol with minimum engagement of vehicles and staff;
- 4) Wash along with cleaning of drains will be run by the volunteers supervised by local staff;
- 5) Stringent measures to combat the spiraling of the corona positivity in camp- 1E, 1W, 2W, 3, 4, 4 Extension, 15 and 24 will be ensured through motivation and enforcement simultaneously;
- 6) Home based care for COVID patient at FDMN camps is strictly prohibited;
- 7) Actor/agency under WHO/health sector will enhance their qualitative and quantitative capacity to curve the spread of corona virus.
